APPENDIX 12 PARAGRAPH 12.8

ENHANCED TAXIWAY CENTRE LINE MARKING

Release Date: 15-02-2012

The General Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) is to amend regulations related to Aerodromes, specifically with the addition of regulations to enhanced taxiway centre line markings.

ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPS) Annex 14 Volume 1 (Aerodromes) publishes SARPS that have not been incorporated into the GCAA Civil Aviation Regulations, CAR Part IX. (Refer to ICAO Annex 14 (Volume 1) paragraph 5.2.8.

It is intended that these SARPS will be adopted into CAR Part IX (Aerodromes) at Appendix 12, paragraph 12.8, Taxiway Centre Line Marking.

1 CAR PART IX (Aerodromes) Appendix 12, paragraph 12.8 Taxiway Centre Line Marking

1.1 Where it is necessary to denote the proximity of a runway-holding position, enhanced taxiway centre line marking shall be provided.

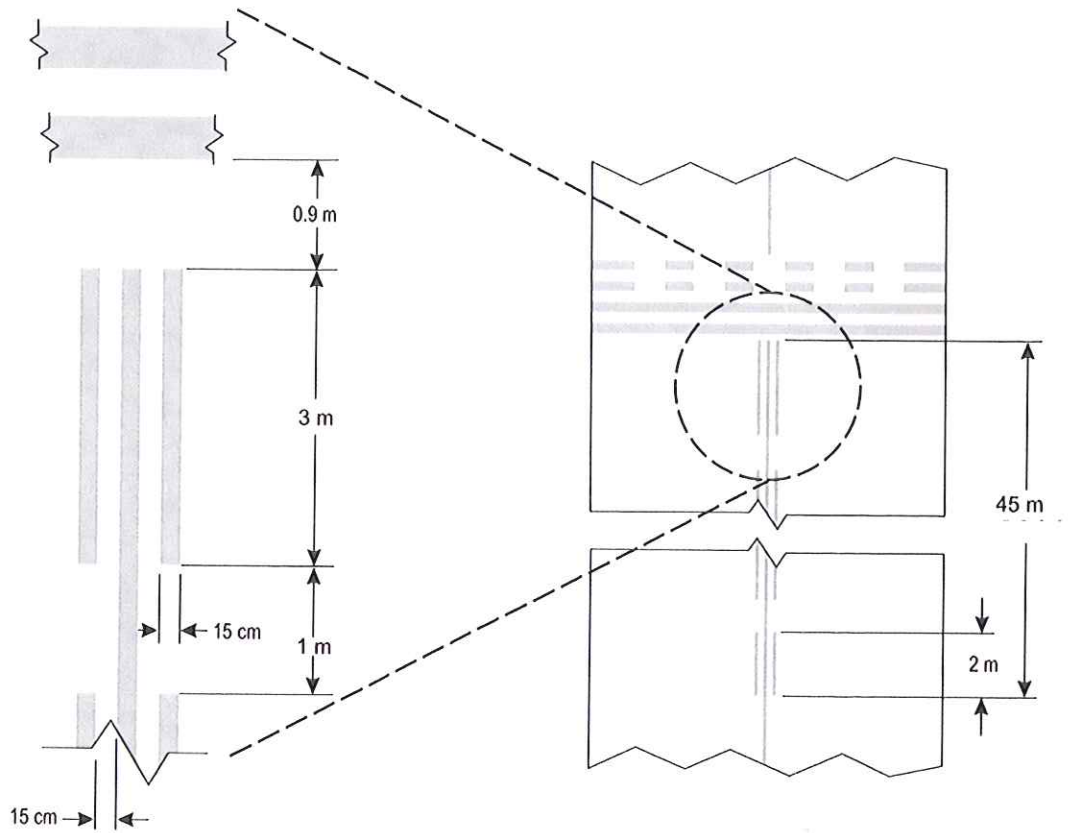
Note: The provision of enhanced taxiway centre line marking may form part of runway incursion prevention measures.

1.2 Where provided, enhanced taxiway centre line marking shall be installed at all taxiway/runway intersections at that aerodrome.

2. Location

Where provided, an enhanced taxiway centre line marking shall extend from the runway-holding position Pattern A (as defined in Figure 1, Enhanced Taxiway Centre Line Marking) to a distance of up to 45 m (a minimum of three (3) dashed lines) in the direction of travel away from the runway or to the next runway holding position, if within 45 m distance.
