### **SUBJECT:**

TYPICAL HAZARDS TO BE CONSIDERED WHILE PLANNING RESUMPTION OF OPERATIONS

### **REFERENCE PUBLICATIONS:**

SAFETY DECISION 2020-17 - OPERATIONS RESUMPTIONS PLANNING

### **REASON / PURPOSE:**

Due to the complexity in attempting to restart or resume/increase operations after air travel restrictions caused by COVID-19 pandemic are gradually eased, the GCAA has published SAFETY DECISION 2020-17 to require organizations to plan their gradual, orderly and safe resumption to operations.

This Safety Alert is issued to guide the aviation organisations to identify hazards that can emanate from the resumption of operations by referring them to useful publications.
