**Subject :** Renewal of AMO Approval

The United Arab Emirates General Civil Aviation Authority in accordance with the provisions of the regulation issues approvals to Maintenance Organisations for carrying out necessary maintenance on UAE registered aircraft and release them back to service. As per the provisions of the regulation these approvals are issued for an initial period of one year, which can be renewed annually on compliance of stipulated requirements.

In the recent past, it has been observed that many organisations are not renewing their approval upon expiry although they continue to exercise the privileges of their approval as valid AMO. This violation is seriously viewed by the GCAA.

In view of the foregoing, being a UAE GCAA approved maintenance organisation, you are hereby informed that if your management is desirous to renew the approval, the process for the same should be initiated 30 days prior to the expiry date.

If the organisation fails to renew the approval upon expiry, the approval will be treated as null and void without any further communication.
