Subject : **Aircraft Security Search Check List**

Various documents require that operators ensure that there is on board certain specific aircraft security search check lists. Chapter 13 of ICAO Annex 6 in paragraph 13.3 requires that there be on board a checklist of the procedures to be followed in searching for a bomb in case of suspected sabotage as well as a checklist for inspecting aircraft for concealed weapons, explosives and other dangerous devices.

Part VII of Section 3.0 of the UAE CARs also specifies such instructions with some further elaboration in Annex B to Section 9.0. However, neither document provides a model, standardized search checklist for each of the contingencies involved. It is important that such checklists be standardized and applied by all operators registered in the UAE.

Therefore, enclosed you will find two model checklists which should be reproduced and carried on board aircraft, either incorporated into the Operations Manual or under separate cover. It is intended that the checklists will be appropriately included in Part VII of the 2003-2 Issue of the UAE CARs.
