Subject: LIMITATION ON MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Certain cases have been brought to the notice of the GCAA where the limitation imposed on the medical certificate of the candidate was not removed in a timely fashion.

After carefully studying these cases the GCAA has come to the following conclusion;

This practice causes not only unnecessary anguish and anxiety to the candidate but also makes them vulnerable to other undesired consequences. On the other hand it could prove to be a major operational and administrative inconvenience to the operator/employer.

In order to avoid this the GCAA requires that once the AME decides that the existing limitation on a medical certificate is no longer required they should immediately inform the GCAA of the fact, providing necessary documentation and requesting for the removal of the limitation.

On review of all the pertinent documents and assessment of the case the GCAA will advise whether or not the limitation can be removed and if so whether it requires the Convening of a Board.
