Subject : **Restructure of the Flight Safety & Security Department
(Formerly Flight Safety Services Department)**

The GCAA is committed to ensure that the responsibilities for the safety for air transportation are properly discharged. It is thus necessary to establish an effective management structure that is able to meet existing and potential safety and security threat.

A restructuring exercise to improve the current Flight Safety and Security Department has been finalized. The GCAA trusts that this improvement will provide a clear line of authority and more importantly, establish specific duties to those concerned.

This organisational restructuring takes effect from 1st January 2004 and are as follows:

- a) Flight Operations section.
 - Chief: *Captain Mohamed Al Sam*
- b) Aviation Security Section (formerly Security Policy & Regulatory Section)
 - Chief: *Mr. Osama Alameri*
- c) Regulation and Investigation Section (new entity)
 - Chief: *Captain Philip Smith*
- d) Flight Safety & Security Department
 - Advisor: *Mr. Leslie Armen*

The new organisational structure involving the Flight Safety & Aviation Security Department is attached for your attention. Operators' cooperation and assistance in this matter is solicited in order to promote flight safety and enhance aviation security.
