**Subject:** AUTHORISED FORMS, STAMP & FOCAL POINT OF CONTACT

Please find attached herein the revised GCAA Medical Reports and Medical Certificates Forms with the new logo for your information and further appropriate action.

Also, please note, following needs to be adhered to by all concerned;

1. The temporary medical certificate issued on behalf of the GCAA by the authorized Aeromedical Examiners and the Permanent Medical Certificate issued by the GCAA are the only authorized document to be recognized as a valid UAE Medical Certificate;
2. When the AME informs the GCAA about a pilot's sickness for over 20 days, they are automatically temporarily suspended. However, to reinstate their licence, the GCAA needs to be informed about their medical fitness to fly. For a cabin crew, if after a period of 20 days the cabin crew is fit to fly, can return to flying without informing the GCAA. Only for cases, where the crew is unfit to fly and recommended permanent suspension from your side, the GCAA needs to be informed to take the final decision.
3. All the Aeromedical Examiners must sign and stamp the Medical Reports and Certificates (using GCAA authorized stamp) and any other documents they evaluate on behalf of the GCAA;
4. Only authorised personnel should communicate with regard to medical and licensing issues with the licensing section.
