SUBJECT : WITHDRAWAL OF AIRCRAFT RADIO INSTALLATION CERTIFICATE

The original installation of aircraft radio equipment as all other equipments installed on an aircraft is approved by the issuance of a C of A. The radio station installation certificate is also specifically issued to approve an aircraft radio equipment installation.

The GCAA in its efforts to reduce unnecessary burden on the owners and the operators of the UAE registered aircraft and in order to streamline aircraft C of A issuance process has decided to stop issuing radio station installation certificate. Therefore with effect from the date of the issue of this Information Bulletin, applications for the issuance of a C of A are no longer required to submit a completed AD 107 Form, and the certificate is no longer required to be carried onboard an aircraft.

The above shall not be confused with the requirement to carry a valid radio station license issued by the Telecommunication Regulatory Authority (TRA) which is still required.
