All concerned UAE operators are advised that, the GCAA E-Examination for Air Law for Flight Crew and full examinations for Aircraft Maintenance Engineers' shall commence from 29th October 2006 in Dubai and Abu Dhabi simultaneously.

Having taken consideration of industry demand, in order to familiarize the candidates with new E-Examination system, GCAA has introduced a comprehensive Training Manual as advised vide GCAA Information Bulletin No. 16/2006 dated 15th July 2006, copy of which is attached herein for your reference. Therefore, all concerned are advised to provide a thorough introduction to their respective candidates.

Following changes shall also be applied in the new system:

Flight Crew Air Law Examination:



Although the pattern of the exam shall remain same, the passing percentage will be raised to 75% instead of currently followed 70%. This change is made in conformity with JAR requirements.

LAME Examination:

In the current system 2 essay questions are asked for each category of exam and air legislation. However, in the new system this practice shall be abandoned and the passing percentage of multi-choice shall be raised to 75% instead of currently followed 70%. This change is made in conformity with JAR requirements.

However, at the time of oral examination, the candidate may be asked essay questions.
