SUBJECT : THE SCREENING OF LIQUIDS, GELS AND AEROSOLS TAKEN ON BOARD AIRCRAFT

The Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) has issued recommended interim security control measures for the screening of liquids, gels and aerosols that may be used in improvised explosive devices on board an aircraft (reference is made to ICAO Confidential State Letters **AS 8/11-06/100** dated 1 December 2006 and **AS 8/11-07/26** dated 30 March 2007). To this effect, in order to harmonize the implementation of such measures with other States the GCAA is adopting the recommended interim measures to be applied at/on UAE airports and operators as stated in the enclosed SL AS 8/11-07/26 herewith (also in Arabic).

The introduction of the recommended interim security control guidelines in regard to the screening of liquids, gels and aerosols is to commence at/on UAE airports and airlines as of **01 May 2007** with measures to be fully implemented by no later than **30 June 2007**. The GCAA shall be informed if difficulties are encountered in implement the referenced measures meanwhile.
