**SUBJECT** : UNCLAIMED DANGEROUS GOODS consignments

ALL OPERATORS / FREIGHT FORWARDING AGENCIES  
**DATE** : MONDAY, 30<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2007

In order to ensure safe operating environment and to protect the interest of all stakeholders at UAE airports in regard of unclaimed dangerous goods consignments (cleared / received). The following shall be noted if a consignment is not cleared / received by the consignee within 30 days from the date of arrival:

- a) UAE airport ground handling agencies must follow-up with operator / consignee and provide the GCAA with the list of pending consignments;
- b) Operators shall take the necessary measures to re-ship the consignment to origin, at the operator or consignor cost and responsibility.

In regard of leaking/damaged dangerous goods consignment when arrived at UAE airports, the operator transported the consignment is responsible for its return to point of origin as per UAE Civil Aviation Regulation Part 6 Chapter 2, unless otherwise specified by GCAA.

Industry shall comply with content of this Information Bulletin **31<sup>st</sup> August 2007**.
