SUBJECT : REINSTATEMENT OF MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Please be informed that the flight crew and the ATC who are medically unfit for more than 20 days, the approved AMEs are required to inform the GCAA for reinstatement of their licence, as mentioned in the Civil Aviation Law, Article No. 26 (3) (b).

The reinstatement process by the GCAA shall be as follows;

1. The Licensing & Aeromedical Section will process the Reinstatement request received from the approved AME within 72 hours, provided all the medical reports submitted are acceptable; and/or
2. If the Clinic has not received any intimation from the GCAA within 72 hours, reinstatement request sent by the AME to be treated as "Fit to Fly and/or Control" and the candidate can resume his duties.
3. In cases, where the GCAA request for extra medical tests and reports, these crew medicals will be kept pending until it's resolved.
