Dear All,

Please be reminded that the GCAA is still waiting for the Implementation Plan from some of the operators who have yet not submitted, to enable GCAA to insert the Action Plan in the ICAO Website.

Also, all are requested to immediately submit the request to endorse the English Language Proficiency (ELP) on pilot licences who are ready with ELP – Level 4 and above, to enable them to fly by 05th March 2008.

For those pilots who has not reached English Language Proficiency (ELP) – Level 4 by 05th March 2008, a sticker will be supplied by the GCAA for the operator to endorse – “ ELP – Not Tested” on their pilot licences. This will be supplied based on the request received.

For Private pilot who flies in the U.A.E. FIR do not require this proficiency, but all GCAA PPL holders engaged in international flying outside U.A.E. FIR must comply with this English Language Proficiency requirement.
