- 1. OBJECTIVE:** This information bulletin is being issued to advise all UAE registered Aircraft Owners/Operators and GCAA approved Maintenance Organizations of the legal requirements governing the validity of certificates that have been issued by the GCAA.

5. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS :

The GCAA would like to remind all owners/operators of UAE registered aircraft that they have to advise the GCAA Airworthiness Department of any changes to the ownership, lease agreements and mortgage of their aircraft. This is to allow the GCAA to review the ownership qualifications of the aircraft and to ensure that the regulation in Section 1, Chapter 1 of CAR Part 5 regarding qualifications of persons has not been compromised.

Organizations possessing the GCAA issued Certificate of Registration, Certificate of Airworthiness and Noise certificate are obliged to return all these certificates to the GCAA Airworthiness Department immediately when there are any changes to the ownership of the aircraft.

This Information Bulletin is also to advise all organizations which are entrusted to keep aircraft records, log books and maintenance records on behalf of the Operator/Owner that under UAE Law and current GCAA regulations, the Owner is responsible for the operation of the aircraft and all the relevant maintenance records. In the event of a change of Operator, these records will have to be furnished to the new Operator/owner.
