1. PURPOSE

The objective of this Information Bulletin is to advise UAE Operators, applicants and holders of UAE Aircraft Maintenance Engineers license, about implementation of CAR 66 and to provide guidance for using appropriate AMEL application form.

2. APPLICABILITY

The information bulletin is applicable to UAE Operators, applicants and holders of UAE Aircraft Maintenance Engineers license.

3. REFERENCE

This IB refers to IB 04/2011 and CAAP 28.

4. RE-SIT EXAMINATIONS

GCAA will continue to accept applications for re-sit examinations from applicants who are under old examination process in accordance with the provisions of Para 17 (a) of CAAP 28 (issue 2, dated 1st July 2011). All re-sit candidates are required to apply for re-sit using old application Form 07.

5. NEW AMEL CAR 66 APPLICATION FORMS

(a) All applicants for CAR 66 license shall use new application forms. However, application for new GCAA basic exam must wait until 1st of October 2011 as the GCAA will not be conducting any modular examination until that date.

(b) Holders of old UAE AME license who are due to convert their license as per conversion schedule in the IB 04/2011 need to apply for conversion I of their licenses using new application forms AMEL 5. If the application is found satisfactory, GCAA will issue converted CAR66 AMEL with full renewed validity. GCAA will not accept fast track applications for license conversions.

(c) Holders of old UAE AME Licenses who are not required to convert their licenses immediately but need to apply for extension/endorsements on their licenses sooner than the dates mentioned in the conversion schedule in the IB 04/2011, should apply simultaneously for extension/type rating endorsement using new application forms AMEL 2 or AMEL 7 as applicable and apply for conversion of their licenses using new application form AMEL 5.
