### 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Information Bulletin (IB) is to inform the aviation industry of the discontinuation of the ACS airworthiness certificate granted to the organizations supplying aeronautical components.

### 2. APPLICABILITY

This IB applies to all aeronautical components suppliers based in the U.A.E.

### 3. CANCELLATION

Publication to be cancelled as a result of ACS approval discontinuation;

- Airworthiness Notice No.22
- CAR Part III, Chapter 6.10.2 and Chapter 8.3.1 (d)
- Appendix V to GCAA CAR Part V, Chapter 3 - CAR 145
- Information Bulletin (IB) 14/2006 - Category 5





#### 4. REQUIREMENTS

With immediate effect, all suppliers of aeronautical components based in the U.A.E. are no longer required to hold an airworthiness certificate granted by Airworthiness Department.

However, before conducting their business, suppliers are required to hold a valid Security Clearance granted by GCAA Security Affairs.

Suppliers holding an ACS approval are requested to approach GCAA Security Affairs before expiry of their certificates.

Alternatively, the GCAA Airworthiness Department will ensure during the safety oversight, that U.A.E. operators and U.A.E. based maintenance organizations have a system to monitor these suppliers.
