**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Information Bulletin (IB) is to:

- inform the industry of the formation of Industry Rulemaking Advisory Group (IRAG) who will be in charge of contributing to the drafting of the new UAE CAR OPS regulations; and
- request the operators to nominate their representatives who will contribute to the IRAG.

**REQUIREMENTS**

In 2014, the GCAA decided to adopt the new European Air Operations Regulations framework with pertinent adaptations to fit within UAE environment.

Hence, Operators are requested to nominate persons to be their representatives in the IRAG to:

- ensure active industry participation in the introduction of the proposed rules;
- facilitate the discussion of any issues at an early stage of the rulemaking process;
- provide input on the implementation of the new rule;
- provide input on the coherence between existing and proposed rule; and
- provide, on request by the GCAA, advice on any specific technical aspects.

The GCAA will not be bound by any advice given by the IRAG.
