BACKGROUND

The current UAE aircraft certificates layout has been amended for ease of identification of the aircraft information shown on a certificate as well as name of the State and Authority issuing the certificate.

The new layout of aircraft certificates includes standardisation of certificate sizing, spacing, margins, font, font size, icons, information orientation, placement of certificate reference number and placement of certificate name.

It is to be noted that the content of aircraft certificates have not been changed as a result of the amendment; and they still include the information required by the applicable ICAO Annexes as ratified by the UAE.

PURPOSE

This IB serves to notify UAE operators on the new layout of aircraft certificates to be issued for (A6) aircraft.

The certificates reviewed and referred in this Information Bulletin are the following airworthiness certificates:

- AWF-COR-007 – Certificate of registration
- AWF-COR-009 – Certificate of de-registration
- AWF-COA-006 – Certificate of airworthiness
- AWF-COA-007 – Certificate of airworthiness for export
- AWF-COA-010 – Certificate of airworthiness for Balloon
- AWF-ARC-015a – Airworthiness review certificate
- AWF-ARC-015b – Airworthiness review certificate – CAMO
- AWF-NOS-002 – Noise Certificate

REQUIREMENTS

The GCAA will start using the new aircraft certificate layout with immediate effect.

The aircraft certificates issued for A6 registered aircraft before the publication of this Information Bulletin are not affected by the amendment.

Nevertheless, UAE operators can request replacement of a current aircraft certificate by submitting application form AWF-CAC-001 and paying the applicable fee of 500 AED.
