Participants will be able to assess the operational management and control systems of an airline as the program is an internationally recognized and accepted evaluation system also will be able to recognize the IOSA auditing standards which have been developed by IATA in collaboration with various regulatory authorities. Participants will have a comprehensive overview of the IOSA Standards Manual 13th edition effective 1 September 2019. They will also learn how to comply with the latest IOSA provisions for Safety Management Systems (SMS).
