



DG DIRECTIVE 03-2015

Issued: 12 MAY 2015

SUBJECT: YEMEN AIRSPACE

APPLICABILITY:

All UAE AOC/POC Holders

EFFECTIVE DATE:

12 MAY 2015

DESCRIPTION:

There is a significant risk to aviation overflying the Yemen Arab Republic including the Sanaa Flight Information Region (OYSC FIR), due to ongoing violence, unrest, security operations and the risk to flight safety from weapons used in the conflict.

REQUIREMENTS:

The DG Directive 02-2015 dated 26th March 2015 on Sanaa FIR is hereby revised as follows.

All UAE AOC/POC holders are prohibited from operating in Sanaa FIR until further notice with the exception of the following routes/airways.

- a. B400
- b. UB403
- c. B404

A specific authorization from the GCAA Flight Operations department is required for any UAE operator intending to operate along Airways B400, UB403 and B404. The authorization requires the following submission

- a. Application letter
- b. Details on routing and frequency



- c. Risk assessment
- d. Method on how continuous monitoring and assessment on the developments will be conducted to ensure continued safe operations.

This directive supersedes the previous DG Directive 02-2015 dated 26th March 2015.
