SUBJECT:

FLEXIBILITY PROVISIONS DUE TO NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) FOR AIRWORTHINESS REVIEW CERTIFICATE

APPLICABILITY:

This SAFETY DECISION does not apply to:

- a) initial issuance of ARC; and
- b) individual aircraft with expired ARC.

INTRODUCTION:

Following SAFETY DECISION 2020-04, a new specific SAFETY DECISION is required for Airworthiness Review Certificate for UAE registered aircraft

REQUIREMENTS:

- a) All individual aircraft ARC which are due to expire by end of May, 2020 may be extended for 3 months, from the date of expiry shown on the certificate provided that the Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisation (CAMO):
 - 1) Ensures the aircraft complies with **CAR M.901(b)** (i.e. aircraft in controlled environment);
 - 2) Ensures that the maintenance of the aircraft is performed in accordance with the approved maintenance program as specified in CAR M.302;
 - 3) Ensures compliance with **CAR M.901(k)** (i.e. aircraft is airworthy);
 - 4) issues a Compliance Statement by CAMO Post holder or ARC staff that the aircraft is airworthy and in compliance with the Type Certificate Data Sheet;
 - 5) Informs Air Operators to place a copy of this Safety Decision, facing the present individual aircraft ARC (carry on board aircraft), for all aircraft affected by this ARC expiry extension for 3 months, from date of expiry shown in the certificate.
- b) Payment of ARC fee renewal will be deferred for 3 months (limited to ARC extended).
- c) The GCAA Airworthiness will process the ARC renewal/endorsement closure to the date of expiry of the extension. The ARC renewal issuance date will start from the day of the renewal/endorsement and the expiry date will be 12 months from the renewal issuance date.
